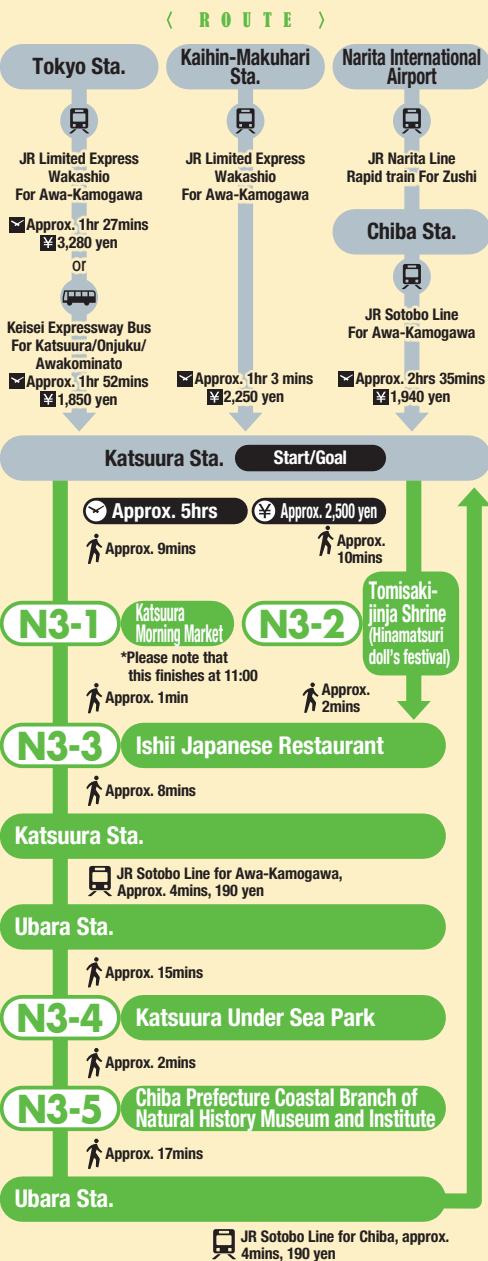


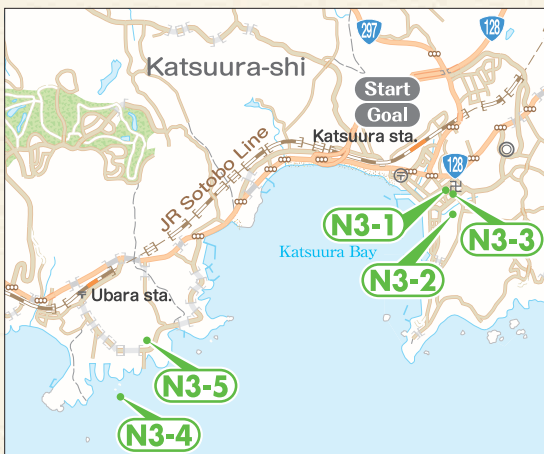
N3 Encounter history and culture in Katsuura ROUTE

As the morning market in Katsuura is livelier in early morning, we advise you to get there as early as possible. The Tomisaki-jinja Shrine "Big Hinamatsuri" doll's festival is held from late February to early March. If you are visiting in this season you should by all means swing by. Extra large dolls adorn the top steps. Illuminations held.

N3-3 Ishii Japanese Restaurant

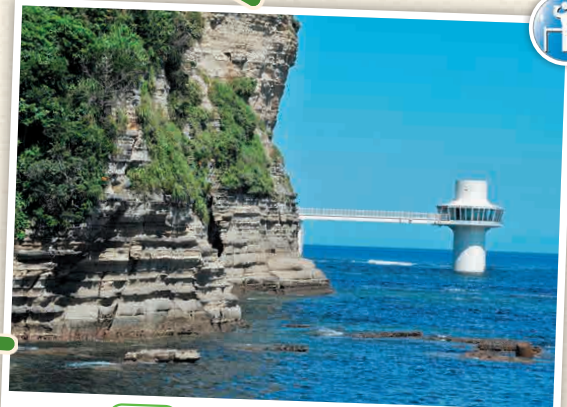
Specialize in spicy "Tantan-men" noodles topped with minced meat and fried onions. Fish dishes using local produce are recommended.
