

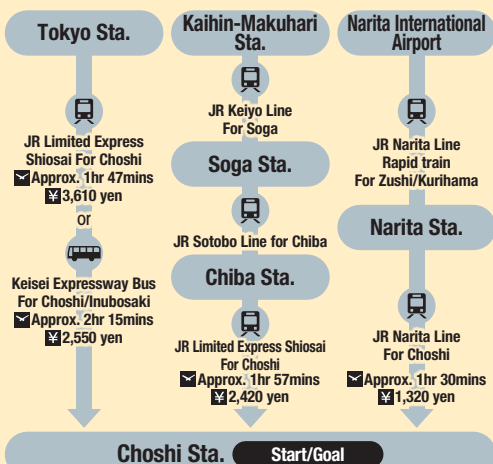
HI A full line-up of activities to encounter Japanese cuisine ROUTE

Confirm in advance as there are only one to two trains per hour on Choshi Electric Railway Line. The "Misaki-meguri" headland shuttle bus also leaves from bus stop area 4 of JR Choshi Station on Sat., Sun., public holidays (every day during summer season). Get off at "Daiichi Sakana-ichiba" (First fish market). While there are fish wholesale markets numbered one to three, only wholesale market one is open for tours.
